On May 29, 2015, Brentwood Park Elementary School hosted a Hip Hop celebration, performing to a full house of parents, students and staff. Under the direction of instructor, Sue Cejalvo-Howse, of 1-Vibe Entertainment, students in kindergarten through grade 7 performed a variety of dances to music with an international flair.

Each year, 1-Vibe Entertainment hosts "School Hip Hop Workshops" across the district. The company works with students to hone their dance skills, culminating with a school-wide performance at the end of the two-week session. The final performance is a dance extravaganza with the added, much-anticipated routine from the Brentwood Park staff. The focus of the program includes team building, refining musicality and rhythm, fostering respect, kindness and determination, and honing leadership skills. Ultimately, students are encouraged to create dances of their own.

This evening, students and staff from Brentwood Park Elementary, under the direction of 1-Vibe Entertainment, will perform a segment of their year-end finale.
