Burnaby North has been chosen as one of six initial schools in Canada to offer an innovative new diploma program, the AP Capstone Diploma program, for those seeking greater academic challenges. It will be offered as an option for students in the fall of 2014.

This eight-week, after-school program addresses trauma through the back door, focusing on developing competence and providing support rather than directly addressing emotional or behavioural problems.
